	prohibition of mandatory mandate, the status of parliamentarian and the related			
	guarantees, the sources of parliamentary law, the internal organization of the			
	Chambers, the planning of the work and parliamentary procedures (legislative,			
	cognitive, inspection, address, control and fiduciary procedures), relations
