<b>Description</b>	<p>Ecclesiastical law traditionally represents the border area where it is possible to verify the effectivity of religious freedom or, using the terms in the sense of the international law conventions, freedom of thought, conscience and religion.</p> <p>Regarding peculiarly the Italian system, but not limiting to it the general perspective, classes show the order of constitutional sources, the typical bilateral legislation, objections of conscience, religious teachings, the structure of ecclesiastical bodies.</p> <p>The last part of the course will be about the criminal law rules concerning</p>
