Contents and goals	The goals of the course: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • illustrate, through basic models, the functioning of the economy as a whole; • examine the causes of economic fluctuations and the role of anti-cyclical policies; • provide essential knowledge on the factors of long-term economic growth. Learning outcomes: acquisition of the basic notions and analytical tools to examine the functioning of the economy; knowledge of the main models for examining the role of economic policies; knowledge of the main macroeconomic theories.
Detailed description	Main topics: Macroeconomic indicators: GDP, Fluctuations, Inflation, Unemployment. The Keynesian model: the Expenditure-Output model (Keynesian cross) and the multiplier effect IS-LM Mundell-Fleming model in open economies Labour market: neoclassical and Keynesian approaches The Phillips' curve Aggregate supply and demand: AD-AS model
Teaching methods	The course consists of theoretical lectures, where models are presented and solved, and applied lectures, based on the analysis of real-world cases
